

Pet Rules

We are delighted to finally offer a vacation rental where our guests can bring their pets. Here are the rules for accommodating your furry family members safely in our space:

1. Be sure to bring a crate, leashes, food dishes, litter pans & kitty litter and dog poop bags!!
2. We must be notified in advance that you will be bringing pets so that our staff can prepare the space accordingly. You will be charged an additional fee to cover these services.
3. We can only accommodate two pets at a time.
4. The yard is not fenced. Help us be good neighbors and do not permit your pet to wander in the surrounding fields, as they do not belong to us. Our Guide to West Fulton lists ample hikes and swimming adventures where you can take them for off-leash time.
5. After your adventures, please towel off your pets before coming in to the main house. A basket with “pet towels” is beside the door.
6. We will have slip covers on all of the living room furniture to enable cuddles on the couch. Please do not remove these.
7. Unattended pets must be crated while you are out.
8. Please clean up after your pet. Kitty litter and dog poop need to be tied up in bags. They can be discarded in the blue trash cans located under the stairs beside the post office across the street.
9. Please keep pets off the beds and upstairs couch.
10. Pets must not be permitted on farm tours. We’re just like you. We LOVE animals...which you’ll see if you decide to come up the road for a tour of the farm. To protect our livestock, we cannot allow any animals to come onto the property, so please leave them home at Tibbets House in their crates. Thank you for helping us to keep everyone safe!
